Case	Stb
AP260	M/25, Cord compression at C7 to T1. Debulking on intraspinal tumor.
AP261	M/51. Hypertension & proteinuria. Younger brother had renal disease requiring transplant. Renal biopsy (IF study not contributory).
AP262	F/75, Intestinal obstruction. Hx of CA cervix with radiotherapy > 10 years ago. Small bowel resection.
AP263	M/42 Left lower lobe lung mass. No previous history of cancer.
AP264	M/63 Endoscopic submucosal dissection of gastric lesion.
AP265	M/31, known to have AIDS. Postmortem lung for comment.
AP266	F/35, presenting with vaginal bleeding. Uterine curetting performed.
AP267	F/9, presenting with headache, accompanied by nausea and vomiting. CT scan showed 7.5 cm enhancing tumor in right frontal and anterior parietal lobes.
AP268	F/38, Endoscopic excision of recurrent right nasal tumor

AP253	F/46, Right lobe of thyroid	Psammoma bodies (without papillary ca)
AP254	F/70, Left thigh tumor resected 30 years ago. Increasing swelling of previous excision site for recent 3 years.	Gauzeoma (retained gauze)
AP255	M/76, Multiple polyps (>160) of ascending, transverse and sigmoid colon.	Pneumatosis intestinalis
AP256	F/47, Left lower lung mass	Lymphoepithelioma-like carcinoma
AP257	F/35, Tissue mass passed per vaginally	Hydatidiform mole, favor partial mole
AP258	M/50, History of recurrent pleomorphic adenomas, Mandibulectomy for cystic mass in mandible.	Carcinoma ex pleomorphic adenoma
AP259	M/54, Left eye sub-conjunctival mass.	Giant cell angiofibroma
